Abstract Submission

ISAR invites the submission of a 250 word abstract (excluding title, authors, affiliations and e-mail address) for a Podium or a Poster Presentation in Arial 12 in a Word document (no pdf-file). It is expected that abstracts have high academic standard and is written in English.

Pictures, tables and graphs should not be used – text only!

Use the following template:

- Title – Entire title without abbreviations
- Authors and Affiliations – A list of all authors full names and their affiliations
- E-mail address to presenter/first author
- Introduction – A short statement of the purposes of the study
- Materials and Methods – A summary of materials and methods used
- Results – A summary of the results
- Discussion/Conclusion

Podium Format

Most presentations will be set at 7 minutes in length, with an additional 3 minutes allowed for open discussion. Exact timing of all podium presentations will be communicated to you as soon as the final congress program is confirmed. Three to five excellent papers will be selected for a peer review discussion on the topic to be presented

Poster Format (Poster Walk)

Please present your poster in **A0 PORTRATE format (1189 mm x 841 mm)**. All posters presented at the meeting will be published in abstract form in the final congress program book.

Please specify in your e-mail if you would like to present as a Podium Presentation **or** a Poster Presentation. If you would not be the podium or poster presenter, please indicate the name of the presenter!

Note that submitted abstracts will be published and distributed in the program.

There will be an award for the best presentation and best poster.
