### **Leiden - The City**

Leiden is an old University town (1575). The university was given to Leiden after the 80 year war against Spain, the Republic of the Netherlands was established a few years later. Famous professors in Leiden were Boerhaave, Linnaeus, Kamerlingh Onnes and Einstein to mention a few. Rembrandt, the famous painter was born in Leiden in 1606, The Golden Age, and lived here till 1632, when he moved to Amsterdam. The Pilgrim Fathers spend some years in Leiden, before leaving to America, since the Republic of The Netherlands was the only European country with freedom of religion. Typical for old cities in The Netherlands are the small courtyards where people live (35 in Leiden). These can be visited. Leiden still has its old cobblestone appearance with a modern flavor with many boutiques, restaurants, bars etc.
